We circled up to heal together and keep each other safe.

## 410 Residents Participated in weekly community building circles

where they deepened relationships and explored how we can build a world that centers safety and care.



## 4 community conflicts were mediated through our PATH program,

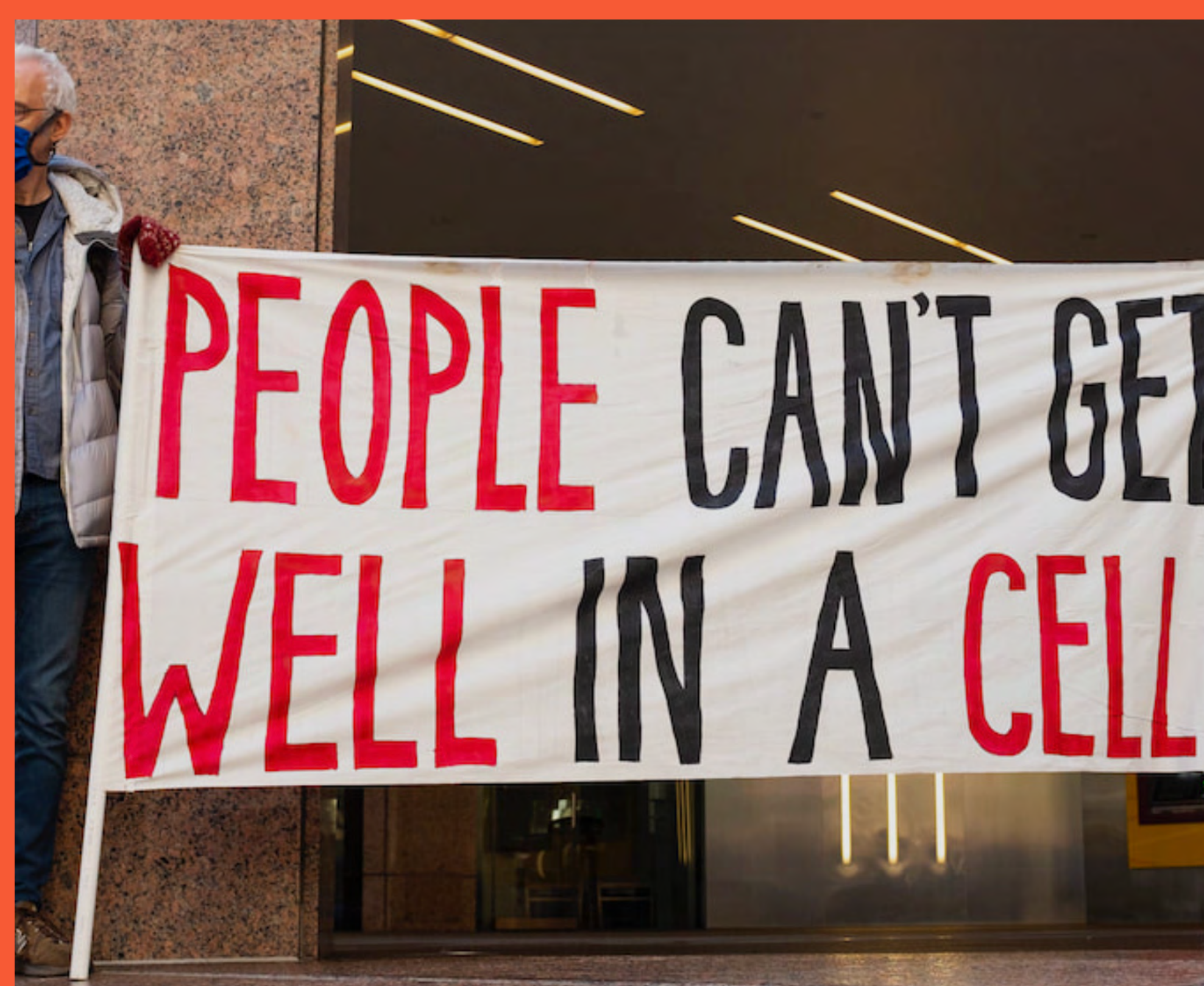
which we will be formally launching as a community resource in 2023.

## \$50 Million Is committed for mental health and supportive housing in Alameda County

as a result of organizing led by Restore Oakland and the Carefirst Community Coalition.

## 560 East Bay residents and community orgs

used our spaces to learn and organize together.



## 80 community members received circle keeping at no cost

They now have the tools to transform conflict in their communities using restorative processes.



We organized with the REAL People's Fund to support black and brown entrepreneurs who have been historically disinvested in.

## 120 small businesses built power through our seasonal markets, townhalls, and monthly support circles–

resulting in winning a Progressive Business Tax in Oakland.
